I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusions

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a Petition for Waiver/Variance of Limited Regulation Carrier Rules (Petition) filed on December 23, 2013, by Luxury Rides, LLC (Petitioner).

2. The vehicle for which a waiver is requested is a 2004 Lincoln Town Car.

3. Commission Staff (Staff) sent a letter to Petitioner on December 30, 2013, informing Petitioner that revisions would need to be submitted to allow the Petition to go on public notice. In particular, Petitioner needed to state which rule a waiver was being sought for, and provide dates for which the waiver was being sought, as these areas of the Petition were left blank.

4. Petitioner did not respond to the letter from Staff. The Petition was not placed on public notice.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The petition of Luxury Rides LLC for a waiver of the Rules Regulating Transportation by Motor Vehicle, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-6, is denied.

2. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails this Decision.

3. This Decision is effective on its Mailed Date.
