Pursuant to Recommended Decision No. R14-0114 in Proceedings Nos. 13A-0046G, 13AL-0067G, and 13AL-0143G ("Consolidated Proceedings") before the Public Utilities Commission of the State of Colorado, which became the Decision of the Commission on February 19, 2014 by operation of law, Rocky Mountain Natural Gas LLC ("Rocky Mountain") herewith submits the following attached Tariff Sheet for filing with the Commission, with an effective date of June 1, 2014.

This initial tariff filing allows Rocky Mountain to recover costs for System Safety and Integrity Projects through the System Safety and Integrity Rider ("SSIR"). Section II.C.1 of the Amended Stipulation approved in the Consolidated Proceedings states, in pertinent part: "The first SSIR filing will be for 2014 and will be made as soon as practicable after Commission approval of the SSIR rider." Pursuant to Rule 1210(b)(II), the foregoing Tariff Sheet is hereby filed on not less than thirty days' notice.

In support of the changes to the SSIR rate in this Advice Letter, Rocky Mountain provides a narrative of each System Safety and Integrity Project included in the 2014 SSIR projection which is included as Attachment 1. Additionally, Rocky Mountain provides the calculation of Eligible System Safety and Integrity Costs of \$1,768,699 for 2014 along with the calculation of the SSIR which, when the Tariff Sheet included with this Advice Letter becomes effective, will recover those costs through December 31, 2014. The SSIR calculations are included as Attachment 2. Because this is the initial SSIR, no SSIR True-Up amounts or Deferred SSIR Balances are included. Those amounts will be included in the filing made on or before November 1, 2015. Second Revised Tariff Sheet No. 8 is included as Attachment 3. The Notice of Change in the Rates is Attachment 4.

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In addition to the changes proposed in this Advice Letter No. 84, Rocky Mountain has proposed in Advice Letter No. 83 that optional seasonal rates become effective on June 1, 2014. The rates other than the proposed SSIR reflect the proposed rates in Advice Letter No. 83. If the rates proposed in Advice Letter No. 83 are changed, the Tariff Sheet included with this Advice Letter No. 84 will be amended to include those changes.
