I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

A. Statement

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a Motion to

Appear *Pro Hac Vice* filed on July 17, 2014 by Susan Stevens Miller, Esq., as attorney for Vote

Solar (Miller Motion) and a Motion to Appear Pro Hac Vice filed on July 23, 2014 by

Matt Vespa, Esq., as attorney for the Sierra Club (Vespa Motion).

2. Commission Rule of Practice and Procedure, 4 Code of Colorado Regulations

(CCR) 723-1-1201(a) governs admissions to appear before the Commission for attorneys not

licensed to practice in Colorado. This rule in turn refers to Colorado Rule of Civil Procedure

(CRCP) Rule 222.1, which lists the requirements that out of state attorneys must meet in order to

appear in Colorado.

3. Ms. Miller is an attorney in good standing in the State of Maryland. She has also

been admitted to appear before the U.S. Supreme Court, the U.S. Courts of Appeals for the

District of Columbia Circuit, and the U.S. Courts of Appeals for the Fourth, Fifth, and Eighth

Circuits. Anotarized Affidavit listing Ms. Miller's education and legal experience was attached to the Miller Motion.

- 4. Mr. Vespa is an attorney in good standing in the State of California. He has also been admitted to appear before the U.S. District Court, Northern District of California, and the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals. A notarized Affidavit listing Mr. Vespa's education and legal experience was attached to the Vespa Motion.
- 5. We find that both motions contain the statements and information required by CRCP 221.1, that the motions state good cause, and that no party will be prejudiced if the motions are granted. We therefore grant the motions.

- 1. The Motion to Appear *Pro Hac Vice* filed on July 17, 2014 by Susan Stevens Miller, Esq., as attorney for Vote Solar is granted.
