I. STATEMENT

- 1. On September 30, 2014, trial Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (Staff) filed a Civil Penalty Assessment Notice (CPAN) No. 109820 with the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (Commission) seeking to assess a penalty, including a surcharge, of \$1,512.50 against U.S. Sedan Service Inc.
- 2. On October 6, 2014, the Director of the Commission issued an "Order Setting Hearing and Notice of Hearing," which scheduled an evidentiary hearing before an administrative law judge (ALJ) on the CPAN for December 18, 2014 at 9:00 a.m.
