I. STATEMENT

1. This proceeding concerns Civil Penalty Assessment Notice (CPAN) No. 110396 issued by Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (Staff) on September 3, 2014 against Respondent Anthony Muzak, doing business as Denver Executive Chauffeur (Denver Executive or Respondent). The CPAN assessed Denver Executive a total penalty of \$1,512.50 for five violations of the *Rules Regulating Transportation by Motor Vehicle, 4 Code of Colorado Regulations 723-6*, including an additional 10 percent surcharge. CPAN No. 110396 was served upon Respondent on September 5, 2014.

2. By the Commission's Order Setting Hearing and Notice of Hearing, a hearing was scheduled to commence in this matter on November 24, 2014. At the scheduled time and place, the hearing was convened. Staff appeared through counsel and Mr. Muzak appeared *pro se*.

3. As a preliminary matter, Staff requested a continuance of the hearing. Due to a medical condition, a witness for Staff was unable to testify. Mr. Muzak did not oppose the request. Based upon good cause shown, the motion was granted. After conferring, the parties agreed to a new hearing date. The hearing will be continued as ordered below.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. The unopposed oral motion by Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission to continue the scheduled hearing in this matter is granted.
