The Commission has jurisdiction over this proceeding pursuant to

2. The first sentence of paragraph 78 on page 25 of this Decision reads as:

In the normal course of the proceeding, as the party that seeks Commission approval or authorization, Black Hills bears the burden of proof with respect to the relief sought; and the burden of proof is preponderance of the evidence.

That sentence states that “Black Hills bears the burden of proof with respect to the relief sought.”

That is incorrect. Black Hills is not the applicant in this proceeding. Public Service Company of Colorado is the applicant. The first sentence of paragraph 78 shall be amended to read as follows:

In the normal course of the proceeding, as the party that seeks Commission approval or authorization, Public Service bears the burden of proof with respect to the relief sought; and the burden of proof is preponderance of the evidence.
