1. Ordering paragraph 3 on page 4 of this Decision reads as:

If this Recommended Decision becomes a decision of the Commission, the waiver and exemption granted by this Decision shall remain in effect for a period of two years from the effective date of this Decision, unless revoked before that date upon notice to Petitioner.

Ordering paragraph 3 states that the waiver and exemption shall remain in effect for "a period of two years" from the effective date of the Decision. That is incorrect. The waiver and exemption are only in effect for one year. Ordering paragraph 3 shall be amended to read as follows:

If this Recommended Decision becomes a decision of the Commission, the waiver and exemption granted by this Decision shall remain in effect for a period of one year from the effective date of this Decision, unless revoked before that date upon notice to Petitioner.
