**I. STATEMENT, BACKGROUND, FINDINGS, AND CONCLUSIONS**

1. Only the procedural history necessary to understand this Decision is included.

This matter concerns Powderhorn Pacific LLC's (Powderhorn) Application for New Permanent Authority to Operate as a Common Carrier by Motor Vehicle for Hire (Application). The Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) scheduled a remote evidentiary hearing for June 30, 2020 on the merits of the Application. Decision No. R20-0364-I issued May 14, 2020.

2. On June 28, 2020, Powderhorn filed an Unopposed Motion to Amend Proposed Authority, Vacate Evidentiary Hearing, and Waive Settlement Deadline (Motion). The Motion states that the parties have reached an agreement which obviates the need for an evidentiary hearing. The Motion asks that the June 30, 2020 evidentiary hearing be vacated, that the Application be amended as set forth in the Motion, and that the amended Application be approved.

3. Because the Motion is unopposed, the ALJ will waive the response time to it. *See* Rule 1400(b), of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* (CCR) 723-1.

4. The ALJ finds that Powderhorn has established good cause to vacate the June 30, 2020 hearing. The ALJ will vacate the hearing. The ALJ will rule on the Motion's additional requests for relief in a separate decision.

## II. ORDER

### A. It Is Ordered That:

1. The June 30, 2020 remote evidentiary scheduled in this matter is vacated.
2. This Decision is effective immediately.
