# STATEMENT

# BY THE COMMISSION:

The summary of the official record in the above entitled application is attached as Appendix A.

Applicant did not request a public hearing.

The Commission has determined this matter upon the record herein without a formal oral hearing pursuant to the provisions of \$40-6-109(5), C.R.S.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

#### THE COMMISSION FINDS:

- 1. As provided by \$40-4-106(2)(a), C.R.S. the Commission has jurisdiction in this matter.
- 2. Notice of this application has been given by the Commission to all interested parties pursuant to \$40-6-108(2), C.R.S.
- 3. All protests, if any, have been withdrawn. All petitions to intervene or other pleadings, if any, are in support of the application.
- 4. All statements contained in this application are adopted by reference as findings of fact.
- 5. The construction as proposed herein is compatible with the public safety, convenience and necessity.

## CONCLUSIONS ON FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. As provided by \$ 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., and Rule 17 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, the Commission may determine this matter without a formal oral hearing.
- The public safety, convenience and necessity requires, and will be served, by the granting of this application as hereinafter ordered.

## THEREFORE THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Authority is granted to the State Department of Highways, Division of Highways, State of Colorado, to construct, operate and maintain a railroad depression in and through the City of Littleton, Arapahoe County, Colorado, including three grade separation structures to carry State Highway 75 (Main Street and Alamo Avenue) and Prince Street over the tracks and facilities of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and the Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad Company.
- 2. Authority is granted to the State Department of Highways, Division of Highways, State of Colorado, to close the existing grade crossing of Ridge Road across the property and tracks of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and the Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad Company in the City of Littleton, Arapahoe County, Colorado upon completion of the three grade separation structures authorized in Ordering Paragraph No. 1 above.
- 3. The State Department of Highways, Division of Highways, State of Colorado shall design and construct all structures to meet or exceed the Commission's Regulations Governing Clearances on Railroads with Reference to Side and Overhead Structures, Parallel Tracks, Crossings of Public Roads, Highways and Streets.
- 4. The State Department of Highways, Division of Highways, State of Colorado shall file with the Commission as late filed exhibits, one copy of the construction plans of each phase of the project to show compliance with the clearance requirements ordered in Paragraph No. 3, above.
- 5. All temporary detour roadway crossings of the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company and the Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad Company necessitated by the construction of this project shall be protected by automatic flashing light signals with short arm gates in accordance with the Agreement by and between the State Department of Highways, Division of Highways, State of Colorado; the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company; and the Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad Company dated April 20, 1985.
- 6. The work to be done and payment therefor shall all be performed and paid by the State Department of Highways, Division of Highways, State of Colorado; the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company; and the Denver and Rio Grande Western Railroad Company as set forth in the plans, specifications, agreement and exhibits, all as filed herein.
- 7. The State Department of Highways, Division of Highways, State of Colorado shall notify the Commission in writing within 10 days of the completion of the project.

8. The Commission hereby retains jurisdiction to make such further order or orders as may be required in the instant matter.

This Order is effective forthwith.
