## STATEMENT, FINDINGS, AND CONCLUSIONS

## BY THE COMMISSION:

- 1. On January 29, 1992, Scanticon-Denver, Inc., doing business as Scanticon-Denver, filed Docket No. 92A-051CP for temporary authority to conduct operations as a common carrier by motor vehicle.
- 2. The Commission gave notice of the application on February 3, 1992. Interventions opposing the application were timely filed by Fred Tiller, doing business as American Limousine Service; Yellow Cab Cooperative Assn., Inc.; Zone Cab Company; and People's Choice Transportation, Inc.
- 3. On March 6, 1991, the Applicant sent a letter to the Commission withdrawing the temporary application. There being nothing further for the Commission to consider, the request will be granted.
