STATEMENT, FINDINGS, AND CONCLUSIONS

BY THE COMMISSION:

- 1. On March 4, 1992, Phyllis J. Johnson, doing business as Colorado Bug Tours (P.J. Enterprizes), filed Docket No. 92A-083CP-Extension-TA for temporary authority to extend operation under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 46968 to include the transportation of passengers, in sightseeing service, between all points in the State of Colorado. Restricted to (1) providing service that originates and terminates at the same point; (2) to the use of vehicles with a passenger capacity of four or less; and, (3) against providing service to points in the County of Routt, State of Colorado.
- 2. Proper notice of the filing of this application was given under \$ 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on March 16, 1992.
- 3. A petition to intervene in the proceeding has been filed by Alpine Taxi/Limo, Inc.
