**COMMISSION ORDER DENYING
EMERGENCY TEMPORARY AUTHORITY**

STATEMENT, FINDINGS, AND CONCLUSIONS

BY THE COMMISSION:

1. On May 19, 1992, Weber Distributing Company, Inc., filed Docket No. 92A-199BY-ETA for emergency temporary authority to conduct operations as a contract carrier by motor vehicle for hire for the transportation of meat and cheese, from the facilities of Bar S Foods in Denver, Colorado to points in Loveland, Fort Collins, and Greeley, Colorado. This application is restricted to providing service for only Bar S Foods.

2. By § 40-6-120, C.R.S., the application for emergency temporary authority is under consideration for a Commission order.

3. Section 40-6-120(1), C.R.S., authorizes the Commission to grant emergency temporary authority when there appears to be ". . . an emergency need to any point or within a territory having no carrier service capable of meeting such need."

4. The Commission finds that the letters filed in support of this application fail to establish that there is an emergency need

for additional transportation services.

5. This application for emergency temporary authority is not in the public interest and should be denied.

THEREFORE THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. This application is denied.

2. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this decision.

3. This Order is effective on its date of mailing.
