STATEMENT, FINDINGS, AND CONCLUSIONS

BY THE COMMISSION:

1. Proper notice of the filing of this application has been given under § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed by any person within the time prescribed. This proceeding is noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

2. The evidence submitted warrants approval of the transfer of control as requested.

3. The transfer is compatible with the public interest.

THEREFORE THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The application of Permian Operating Limited Partnership, doing business as Western Oil Transportation, for authority to transfer control of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 1512&I by virtue of the sale of 100 percent of its parent entities, the Permian Corporation and Permian Partners, is granted.

2. The Certificate will remain in the name of Permian Operating Limited Partnership, doing business as Western Oil Transportation; and, therefore, there are no requirements for issuance of the application.

3. This Order is effective on its date of mailing.
