# COMMISSION ORDER GRANTING EMERGENCY TEMPORARY AUTHORITY

### STATEMENT, FINDINGS, AND CONCLUSIONS

#### BY THE COMMISSION:

- 1. On August 12, 1992, Felix Duran, doing business as Duran Trucking, filed Docket No. 92A-395BY-Extension-ETA for emergency temporary authority to extend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9617 for the transportation of lumber and building materials from points in the Counties of Delta and Montrose, State of Colorado, to all points in the State of Colorado. This application is restricted to providing service for only Louisiana-Pacific Corporation and Sage Brush Sales.
- 2. By \$ 40-6-120, C.R.S., the application for emergency temporary authority is under consideration for a Commission order.
- 3. Section 40-6-120(1), C.R.S., authorizes the Commission to grant emergency temporary authority when there appears to be "... an immediate and urgent need to any point or within a territory having no carrier service capable of meeting such need."
- 4. The support filed on behalf of this application indicates that shippers are in desperate need for the services sought as they have shipments ready to go if Applicant is granted emergency temporary

authority. Shippers also state that they have not been able to find any other companies to do this hauling.

- 5. The Commission finds due to the facts stated in paragraph 4 above, there is an emergency need for additional transportation services. The Commission will grant the application.
- 6. The Applicant has adequate equipment and financial resources to begin immediate service within the scope of the authority sought and is willing, ready, and able to operate under all Commission rules and regulations governing carriers by motor vehicle.
- 7. This application for emergency temporary authority is in the public interest and should be granted.
- 8. The Applicant is advised that the granting of an emergency temporary authority makes no presumption that temporary and permanent authority will be granted.

#### THEREFORE THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. Felix Duran, doing business as Duran Trucking, is granted emergency temporary authority to extend operations under Contract Carrier Permit No. B-9617 for a period of 15 days commencing from the mailed date of this order, with authority as set forth in the attached Appendix.
- 2. Felix Duran, doing business as Duran Trucking, shall not commence operations until all requirements have been met and notice in writing has been received from the Commission that the Applicant is in compliance and may begin service.
- 3. The 20-day time period provided by \$ 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsid-eration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this decision.
