# STATEMENT, FINDINGS, AND CONCLUSIONS

#### BY THE COMMISSION:

1. On November 9, 1992, TenderCare Transportation Services, Inc., filed application (Docket No. 92A-609BP-TA) for temporary authority to conduct operations as a contract carrier by motor vehicle for hire for the transportation of passengers and their baggage, between all points in the State of Colorado. This application is restricted to providing service for only La Quinta Motor Inns, Inc. and Full Circle Inter-Generational Project Groups.

2. Interventions opposing the application were timely filed by Yellow Cab Cooperative Association, doing business as Yellow Cab, Inc. and d/b/a Boulder Yellow Cab, Inc. and its division, Denver Airport Limousine Service, Inc.; Dee Hive Tours; and Black Hawk -Central City Ace Express, Inc.

3. By § 40-6-120, C.R.S., the application for temporary authority is under consideration for a Commission order.

4. Section 40-6-120(1), C.R.S., authorizes the Commission to grant temporary authority when there appears to be ". . . an emergency need to any point or within a territory having no carrier service capable of meeting such need."

5. The support filed on behalf of this application does not establish that there is an immediate and urgent need for transportation services or that there is no carrier capable of providing the service.

6. This application for temporary authority is not in the public interest and should be denied.

# THEREFORE THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. This application is denied.

2. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsid-eration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this decision.

3. This Order is effective on its date of mailing.
