STATEMENT, FINDINGS, AND CONCLUSIONS

BY THE COMMISSION:

1. Proper notice of the filing of this application has been given under § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., and no protest, objection, or petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed by any person within the time prescribed. This proceeding is therefore noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without an oral hearing.

2. To grant the request for a suspension would be in the public interest.

3. The evidence submitted warrants the approval of a suspension of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 19789 as here ordered.

THEREFORE THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 19789 is authorized by the Commission from November 11, 1992 through May 12, 1993.

2. On or before April 1, 1993, Applicant shall file a written request either for an extension of this suspension period, or a request to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 19789. Prior to reinstatement, insurance and tariffs shall be filed.

The failure to file a written request either for an extension of suspension or reinstatement of the certificate and filing of insurance and tariffs will result in revocation of the authority without further notice and without the right to reinstatement.

3. This Order is effective on its date of mailing.
