## STATEMENT

On January 7, 1994, Applicant City of Arvada (Arvada) filed its Notice of Intention to Proceed to Hearing, Motion for Extension of Time, Proposed Order. The Motion seeks an extension of time to and including 10 days after the date of the mailing of the Commission's decision deeming the application complete within which to file its witness and exhibit list. As grounds for the motion it is stated that the timing of events anticipated under emergency Rule 69 is different than the timing of events outlined in the Commission's November 1983 Notice of Application.
