If the Applicants do not comply with the requirements of this ordering paragraph within 60 days of the effective date of this Order then ordering paragraph 1 above, which grants authority to the Transferee, shall be

void, and the authority granted shall then be void.

On good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance, if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.
