I.BY THE COMMISSION:

Statement, Findings and Conclusion:

- 1. The Staff of the Transportation Section of the Commission has received written reports from the Department of Agriculture stating that, due to the coming harvest, additional motor vehicle transportation will be needed for the seasonal movement of crops in various counties throughout the State of Colorado.
- 2. The Commission finds that (a) because of the impending harvest, shortage of authorized motor vehicles will occur for the transportation of farm commodities from fields and farms to railroad loading points, warehouses or other places of storage, or to markets for the commodities and within the

areas described in the attached Appendix; and that (b) the present public convenience and necessity requires the issuance of temporary certificates for the temporary, seasonal operation of motor vehicles for the purpose of transporting the commodities, as provided by § 40-16-110(5), C.R.S.

II.ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. Temporary certificates are authorized for the seasonal operation of motor vehicles for the purpose of transporting crops from fields or farms located within the various counties in the State of Colorado to railroad loading points, warehouses, or other places of storage, or to markets for the commodities within the areas and during the time frames as fully described in the attached Appendix.
- 2.Transportation under the temporary certificates shall be effective from the date of issuance by authorized personnel of the Colorado Ports of Entry or Colorado State Patrol to the expiration date listed on the attached Appendix.
