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**I. BY THE COMMISSION:**

**A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusion**

1. Proper notice of the filing of this application has been given under § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S. Also at that time, this matter was set for hearing before the Commission on January 26, 1996.
2. No protest, objection, or petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed by any person within the time prescribed. This proceeding is therefore noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without an oral hearing.

- 3.To grant the request for a suspension would be in the public interest.
- 4.The evidence submitted warrants the approval of a suspension of  
Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC  
No. 9742 as here ordered.

## **II.ORDER**

### **A.The Commission Orders That:**

- 1.The hearing set for January 26, 1996 is hereby vacated.
- 2.This application was deemed complete on December 20, 1995, within  
the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 3.The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Certificate of  
Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 9742 is  
authorized by the Commission from December 15, 1995  
through June 15, 1996.
- 4.On or before May 15, 1996, Applicant shall file a written request  
either for an extension of this suspension period,  
or a request to reinstate Certificate of Public  
Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 9742. Prior to  
reinstatement, insurance and tariffs shall be filed.  
The failure to file a written request either for an  
extension of suspension or reinstatement of the  
certificate and filing of insurance and tariffs will  
result in revocation of the authority without further  
notice.
