A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusion

- 1.Proper notice of the filing of this application has been given under § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed by any person within the time prescribed. This proceeding is noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.
- 2.Steamboat Transportation Services, Inc., doing business as Steamboat Taxi, Inc., owner and operator of the certificate, seeks approval for the continuation of the encumbrance of Alpine/Limo, Inc. against

- according to the terms agreed to by the Parties in the Uniform Commercial Code Financing Statement UCC-1 and continued by UCC-3 (filing No. 952088149), filed with the Colorado Secretary of State.

- 4. Steamboat Transportation Services, Inc., doing business as Steamboat Taxi, Inc., and Alpine Taxi/Limo, Inc., shall notify the Commission, in writing, of the full satisfaction of the abovestated indebtedness, and release of the authorized encumbrance, within ten days after it has been effected.
