**COMMISSION ORDER  
GRANTING SUSPENSION**

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**I. BY THE COMMISSION:**

**A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusion**

1. Proper notice of the filing of this application has been given under § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S. Also at that time, this matter was set for hearing before the Commission on April 4, 1996.

2. No protest, objection, or petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed by any person within the time prescribed. This proceeding is therefore noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without an oral hearing.

3. To grant the request for a suspension would be in the public interest.

4. The evidence submitted warrants the approval of a suspension of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 45394 as here ordered. However, the Applicant is advised that

the Commission's Rules and Regulations Governing Common Carriers by Motor Vehicle for Hire require that no certificate be suspended for more than 12 consecutive months.

## II. ORDER

### A. **The Commission Orders That:**

1. The hearing set for April 4, 1996 is hereby vacated.
2. This application was deemed complete on February 29, 1996, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
3. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 45394 is authorized by the Commission from February 24, 1996 through August 24, 1996.
4. On or before June 24, 1996, Applicant shall file a written request to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 45394. Prior to reinstatement, insurance and tariffs shall be filed. Failure to file a written request for reinstatement of the certificate and filing of insurance and tariffs may result in revocation of the authority without further notice.

B. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
