**COMMISSION ORDER
GRANTING SUSPENSION**

I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement, Findings, and Conclusion

1. Proper notice of the filing of this application has been given under § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S. Also at that time, this matter was set for hearing before the Commission on June 10, 1996.

2. No protest, objection, or petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed by any person within the time prescribed. This proceeding is therefore noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without an oral hearing.

3. To grant the request for a suspension would be in the public interest.

4. The evidence submitted warrants the approval of a suspension of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 29 as here ordered.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The hearing set for June 10, 1996 is hereby vacated.

2. This application was deemed complete on May 9, 1996, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.

3. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 29 is authorized by the Commission from March 8, 1996 to September 1, 1996.

4. On or before July 1, 1996, Applicant shall file a written request either for an extension of this suspension period, or a request to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 29. Prior to reinstatement, insurance and tariffs shall be filed.

The failure to file a written request either for an extension of suspension or reinstatement of the certificate and filing of insurance and tariffs may result in revocation of the authority without further notice.

B. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
