STATEMENT

On February 20, 1990, Staff filed its Motion for Extension of Time to File Response to Exceptions. Staff seeks a 14-day extension of time within which to file its response to exceptions filed by the Respondent on February 7, 1990. As grounds for the request Staff states that it has been attempting to settle this proceeding and has thus devoted no time to responding to the exceptions.

The motion fails to state good cause and it should be denied.

Generally, good cause consists of events beyond the control of a party which prevent the party from meeting a requirement. Here, there were no such events; Staff candidly admits it voluntarily chose not to devote resources to responding to exceptions. Such choice fails to constitute good cause.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- The Motion for Extension of Time to File Response to Exceptions filed February 20, 1990, by Staff is denied.
