I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION</u>

A. Statement

1. On November 7, 2003, Public Service Company of Colorado (Public Service) filed an application for approval of its 2003-2004 Gas Price Volatility Mitigation Plan for its electric department. Public Service states that it filed this application pursuant to a requirement in the April 4, 2003 settlement agreement approved by the Commission in Docket No. 02S-315EG by Decision No. C03-0670.

2. Staff of the Commission (Staff) timely filed its notice of intervention on December 31, 2003. Staff raises a number of concerns about proposals in the application and requests that the Commission set the matter for hearing.

3. On January 5, 2004, the Colorado Office of Consumer Counsel (OCC) filed an untimely motion to intervene, and requested a waiver of response time to the motion. The OCC states that it initially determined that it would not intervene in the matter, but upon further consideration it wishes to participate, given its involvement in other dockets where similar issues

are addressed. Further, the OCC indicates that according to its initial review of the application its concerns are consistent with those raised by Staff.

4. Good cause having been stated, we grant the OCC's motion for intervention.

5. We find that hearings should be held on the application, and a prehearing conference date should be set.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The application filed by Public Service Company of Colorado in Docket No. 03A-

489G will be set for hearing before the Commission. A prehearing conference is set in this matter as follows:
