I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On November 20, 2003, East West Resort Transportation, LLC., doing business as Colorado Mountain Express &/or CME Premier &/or Premier VIP Transportation &/or Resort Express filed an application seeking approval to abandon operations named in Item B, of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 13123. The complete authority, with Item (B) indicated in bold, is as follows:

Transportation of passengers and their baggage:

- (A) On schedule and in call-and-demand limousine service, between all points in the County of Summit, State of Colorado;
- (B) In taxi service, between all points in the County of Summit, State of Colorado, and between said points, on the one hand, and all points in the State of Colorado, on the other hand.

- 2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on December 1, 2003. The Commission set this matter for hearing on February 4, 2004.
- 3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.
- 4. The information submitted with this application warrants granting the requested partial abandonment.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That

- 1. The hearing set for February 4, 2004, is vacated.
- 2. This application was deemed complete on January 14, 2004, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 3. The application filed by East West Resort Transportation, LLC, doing business as Colorado Mountain Express &/or CME Premier &/or Premier VIP Transportation &/or Resort Express for approval to abandon operations under Item (B) of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 13123 is granted.
- 4. The complete authority under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 13123, after Item (B) is abandoned, shall be as set forth in the Appendix.

- 5. The 20-day time period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Order.
