I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of an unopposed motion to supplement the record filed by Public Service Company of Colorado (Public Service) on December 2, 2003.

2. In Decision No. C03-0899, we granted Public Service's proposed line extension policy in regard to the revision of its Service Lateral Extension and Distribution Main Extension Policy in its P.U.C. No. 6 - Gas Tariff. Public Service proposed a new revenue-based gas construction allowance to replace the gross-embedded investment methodology it had previously utilized. We further ordered Public Service to file tariffs that included a detailed description of the construction allowance (CA) methodology.

3. Public Service subsequently filed Advice Letter No. 619 that included tariff language describing its revenue-based CA methodology. However, in Decision No. C03-1309, we rejected Advice Letter No. 619 and ordered Public Service to resubmit the tariff with a more

detailed description of its methodology, after obtaining consensus of the other parties to this matter.

4. Concurrent with this motion, Public Service states that it is filing Advice Letter No. 621, which reflects the consensus reached among the parties to this matter regarding the description of Public Service's revenue-based CA methodology. Public Service also indicates that as part of the agreement to the language reflected in Advice Letter No. 621, it has agreed to Commission Staff's (Staff) request to supplement the record in this matter with a copy of what Public Service identifies as Exhibit TSJ-1, that contains all the spreadsheet cell formulas revealed, which reflects Public Service's calculation of the CA approved here.

5. Public Service represents that no other party objected to supplementing the record as Staff requested. Public Service also states that Exhibit TSJ-1 will provide the Commission and any interested party with a specific reference regarding the means it utilized to calculate the CA.

6. We find good cause exists to grant the motion.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The motion of Public Service Company of Colorado to supplement the record in this matter is granted.

2. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
