**COMMISSION ORDER GRANTING SCHEDULE
CHANGES ON LESS-THAN-STATUTORY NOTICE**

I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement

1. On January 23, 2004, Four Winds, Inc., doing business as People's Choice Transportation, Inc., ("People's Choice"), filed an application for authority to allow Time Schedule No. 14 to become effective on less-than-statutory notice. People's Choice provides scheduled service between the Bear Valley Shopping Center and Black Hawk, Colorado.

2. People's Choice proposes to eliminate the 11:30 morning stop creating a two-hour break in the schedules.

3. In support of the application, People's Choice states that they are unable to comply with both the extant time schedule and the Commission's regulations covering the number of consecutive hours a driver may operate. Creating a mid-morning break of two hours should remedy the matter.

4. Analysis of Time Schedule No. 14 indicates that it conforms to Appendix A, Section 12(f) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* (CCR) 723-1.

5. Rule 31(f)(1) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 4 CCR 723-1, allows an order authorizing carriers to change tariffs or time schedules on less-than-statutory notice for good cause shown.

6. The Commission finds that good cause has been shown for the approval of the proposed changes in Time Schedule No. 14 and the application should be granted.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The application of People's Choice to publish Time Schedule No. 14 on less-than-statutory notice is granted. Time Schedule No. 14 shall be published on not less than one day's notice.

2. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
