**ORDER GRANTING AMENDED
MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. This matter comes before the Commission for consideration of a motion and amended motion for extension of time to file response filed by Home Builders Association of Metropolitan Denver (HBA) pursuant to 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-22.

2. In its initial motion filed January 28, 2004, HBA requested an extension of time until February 11, 2004 to file its response to the Plan of Reparations filed by Public Service Company of Colorado (Public Service). Public Service filed its Plan of Reparations on January 14, 2004. HBA's response was therefore due by the close of business on January 28, 2004.

3. On February 3, 2004, HBA filed a motion to amend its motion for extension of time to file its response. HBA requested an additional amount of time up to and including February 18, 2004 to file its response to Public Service's Plan of Reparations. HBA further represents that the amended motion is unopposed.

4. We find that HBA has stated good cause to grant its motion to amend the motion for extension of time to respond to Public Service's Plan of Reparations and allow HBA to file its response no later than the close of business on February 18, 2004.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The motion of Home Builders Association of Metropolitan Denver to amend its motion for extension of time to February 18, 2004, to file its response to Public Service Company of Colorado's Plan of Reparations is granted.

2. The original motion of Home Builders Association of Metropolitan Denver for extension of time to file response to Public Service Company of Colorado's Plan of Reparations up to and including February 11, 2004 is therefore rendered moot.
