I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION:</u>

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On March 18, 2004, R & R Transportation, Inc., filed an application seeking

authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN)

PUC No. 55693.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and

corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on March 22, 2004. The Commission set this

matter for hearing on June 4, 2004.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed.

This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined

without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants granting the requested

suspension.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. The hearing set for June 4, 2004, is vacated.
- 2. This application was deemed complete on April 28, 2004, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 3. The application filed by R & R Transportation, Inc., for authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55693 is granted.
- 4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55693 is authorized from March 9, 2004, through May 20, 2004.
- 5. On or before May 5, 2004, R & R Transportation, Inc., shall file a written request either to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55693 or to extend the suspension period.
- 6. Prior to reinstatement, R & R Transportation, Inc. shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules.
- 7. The failure to file a timely written request either to reinstate Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55693 or to extend the suspension period may result in revocation of the certificate without further notice.
- 8. The 20-day time period provided by §40-6-141(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, reargument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Order.

9. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
