I. **BY THE COMMISSION:** 

> A. **Statement, Findings and Conclusions**

On April 19, 2004, Alpine Taxi/Limo, Inc. filed an application seeking authority 1.

to suspend operations under the portion of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity

(CPCN) PUC No. 26246 which authorizes: Transportation of passengers and their baggage, on

schedule, between Steamboat Springs, Colorado, on the one hand, and Aspen and Vail, Colorado,

on the other hand. The requested suspension period is from May 3, 2004 through November 3,

2004.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and

corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on May 3, 2004. The Commission set this matter

for hearing on July 22, 2004.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed.

This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined

without a hearing.

- 4. The information submitted with this application warrants granting the requested partial suspension.
- The application for authority to suspend operations under a portion of CPCN PUC
  No. 26246 is in the public interest.

## II. ORDER

## **A.** The Commission Orders That:

- 1. The hearing set for July 22, 2004, is vacated.
- 2. This application was deemed complete on June 8, 2004, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 3. The application filed by Alpine Taxi/Limo, Inc. for authority to suspend operations under the portion of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 26246 named in Paragraph (A) (1) of this decision is granted.
- 4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under the above-decribed portion of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 26246 is authorized from May 3, 2004 through November 3, 2004.
- 5. On or before October 4, 2004, Alpine Taxi/Limo, Inc. shall file a written request either to reinstate the suspended portion of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 26246 or to extend the suspension period.
- 6. Prior to reinstatement, Alpine Taxi/Limo, Inc. shall file with the Commission the proper tariff.

- 7. The failure to file a written request either to reinstate the suspended portion of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 26246 or to extend the suspension period on or before October 4, 2004 may result in revocation of the suspended portion of the certificate without further notice.
- 8. The 20-day time-period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, re-argument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Order.
  - 9. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
