I. BY THE COMMISSION

A. Statement

1. On June 15, 2004, Octal Resources, Inc., doing business as O'Neal Water Works (O'Neal Water Works) filed Advice Letter No. 3. O'Neal Water Works states that this filing is to implement a proposed water curtailment program to become effective June 17, 2004.

B. Findings of Fact

- 2. Rule 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* (CCR) 723-12-57 requires a fixed utility proposing to change, abandon, discontinue, or curtail any jurisdictional service to file an application with the Commission, at least 30 days before the effective date of the proposed change, abandonment, discontinuance, or curtailment.
- 3. Rule 4 CCR 723-1-41.5 provides a procedure for a fixed utility, upon the filing of a formal application and specific Commission authorization, to change its tariffs upon less than 30 days' notice.

4. O'Neal Water Works failed to file any application seeking Commission authorization to implement its curtailment program. Being fully advised of the facts, the Commission will reject Advice Letter No. 3 filed by O'Neal Water Works.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. Advice Letter No. 3 and accompanying tariff sheet filed by Octal Resources, Inc., doing business as O'Neal Water Works on June 15, 2004, is rejected. Nothing in this Order prohibits Octal Resources, Inc., doing business as O'Neal Water Works from submitting an application to implement its proposed curtailment plan in a timely manner.
 - 2. This Order is effective upon its Mailed Date.
