I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On April 29, 2004, Sandra M. Leedy, doing business as Irie Shuttle Service, (Irie Shuttle Service), filed an application for permanent authority to conduct operations as a common carrier by motor vehicle for hire for the transportation of passengers and their baggage, in scheduled service, between the Hunters Meadows Apartments, 850 East Cheyenne Road, Colorado Springs, Colorado, on the one hand, and the Broadmoor Hotel, 1 Lake Avenue, Colorado Springs, Colorado, on the other hand.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on May 17, 2004. The Commission set this matter for hearing on July 21, 2004.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is noncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants granting the requested authority.

5. The present or future public convenience and necessity requires, or will require, the transportation service as requested.

6. Irie Shuttle Service is ready, willing, and able properly to perform the service as requested.

7. This application for permanent authority is in the public interest.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The hearing set for July 21, 2004, is vacated.

2. This application was deemed complete on June 22, 2004, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.

3. Irie Shuttle Service is granted a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate as a common carrier by motor vehicle for hire with authority as set forth in the Appendix. This Order is a CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY.

4. Irie Shuttle Service shall operate in accordance with all applicable Commission rules and regulations.

5. Irie Shuttle Service shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Irie Shuttle Service shall file a proper tariff and pay the issuance fee and annual vehicle identification fee. Irie Shuttle Service may not begin

operations until these requirements have been met and it has received notice in writing from the Commission stating that it is in compliance and may begin service.

6. If Irie Shuttle Service does not comply with the requirements of this Order within 60 days of its effective date, then the authority to conduct operations shall be void. For good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.

7. This Order is effective immediately on its Mailed Date.
