PERMANENT CONTRACT CARRIER PERMIT**

I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On June 11, 2004, Manor Transport, LLC, doing business as Manor Transport, filed an application for permanent authority to conduct operations as a contract carrier by motor vehicle for hire for the transportation of passengers and their baggage between all points in the Counties of Arapahoe and Jefferson, State of Colorado. This application is restricted: (1) To providing transportation services for passengers who are both recipients of Medicaid and clients of The Manor on Marston Lake, 4800 South Old Wadsworth Boulevard, Littleton, Colorado 80123; and (2) To providing transportation services that originate or terminate at 4800 South Old Wadsworth Boulevard, Littleton, Colorado 80123.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on June 28, 2004. The Commission set this matter for hearing on September 1, 2004.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants granting the requested authority.

5. A present and special need for the requested transportation service exists. A grant of the requested authority will not impair the efficient public service of any authorized common carrier providing a similar service.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The hearing set for September 1, 2004, is vacated.
2. This application was deemed complete on August 3, 2004, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
3. Manor Transport is granted authority to operate as a Class B contract carrier by motor vehicle for hire with authority as set forth in the Appendix. This Order is a PERMIT.
4. Manor Transport shall operate in accordance with all applicable Commission rules and regulations.
5. Manor Transport shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Manor Transport shall file a proper tariff and pay the issuance fee and annual vehicle identification fee. Manor Transport may not begin operations until these requirements have been met and it has received notice in writing from the Commission that it is compliance and may begin service.

6. If Manor Transport does not comply with the requirements of this Order within 60 days of its effective date, then the authority to conduct operations shall be void. For good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.

7. The 20-day time-period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, re-argument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Order.

8. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
