**COMMISSION ORDER GRANTING
PERMANENT CONTRACT CARRIER PERMIT**

I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On July 28, 2004, Right Transportation, LLC (Right Transportation) filed an application for permanent authority to conduct operations as a contract carrier by motor vehicle for hire as follows: Transportation of passengers and their baggage between all points in the Counties of Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Denver, Douglas, and Jefferson, State of Colorado. This application is restricted: (1) to providing transportation service for clients of Jefferson County Department of Human Services, Aging and Adult Services Division, 900 Jefferson County Parkway, Golden, Colorado 80401; and (2) to the transportation of passengers who are recipients of Medicaid.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on August 9, 2004. The Commission set this matter for hearing on October 15, 2004.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants granting the requested authority.

5. A present and special need for the requested transportation service exists. A grant of the requested authority will not impair the efficient public service of any authorized common carrier providing a similar service.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The hearing set for October 15, 2004, is vacated.
2. This application was deemed complete on September 14, 2004, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
3. Right Transportation is granted authority to operate as a Class B contract carrier by motor vehicle for hire with authority as set forth in the Appendix. This Order is a PERMIT.
4. Right Transportation shall operate in accordance with all applicable Commission rules and regulations.
5. Right Transportation shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Right Transportation shall file a proper tariff and pay the issuance fee and appropriate annual vehicle identification fee. Right Transportation may not begin operations until these requirements have been met and it has received notice in writing from the Commission stating it is in compliance and may begin service.

6. If Right Transportation does not comply with the requirements of this Order within 60 days of its effective date, then the authority to conduct operations shall be void. For good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.

7. The 20-day time-period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, re-argument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Order.

8. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
