I. <u>BY THE COMMISSION:</u>

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On August 19, 2004, Owner/Driver United Corporation, doing business as Blue

Sky Shuttle (Blue Sky Shuttle), filed an application for approval to lease Certificate of Public

Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 55725 to Golden West Commuter, LLC (Golden

West Commuter). The lease is for the period from September 1, 2004 through September 1, 2007.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and

corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on August 23, 2004. The Commission set this

matter for hearing on October 28, 2004.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed.

This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined

without a hearing.

- 4. The information submitted with this application warrants granting the requested lease.
- 5. The financial standing of Golden West Commuter has been satisfactorily established.
- 6. Golden West Commuter is ready, willing, and able to properly engage in motor carrier operations under the authority to be leased.
- 7. This application for approval of the lease of CPCN PUC No. 55725 from September 1, 2004 through September 1, 2007 is in the public interest.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

- 1. The hearing set for October 28, 2004, is vacated.
- 2. This application was deemed complete on September 29, 2004, within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
- 3. The application filed by Blue Sky Shuttle for approval to lease Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55725, subject to encumbrances, if any, against the authority to Golden West Commuter from September 1, 2004 through September 1, 2007 is granted.
- 4. Golden West Commuter shall operate in accordance with all applicable Commission rules and regulations.
- 5. Golden West Commuter shall obtain and keep in force the proper liability insurance in accordance with Commission rules. Golden West Commuter shall pay the issuance fee and the appropriate vehicle identification fee. Golden West Commuter shall adopt the tariff of Blue Sky

Shuttle which shall become that of Golden West Commuter until changed in accordance with the public utilities law. An acceptance of lease form signed by both Golden West Commuter and Blue Sky Shuttle shall be filed with the Commission. Golden West Commuter may not begin operations until these requirements have been met and it has received notice in writing from the Commission stating that it is in compliance and may begin service.

- 6. If Blue Sky Shuttle and Golden West Commuter do not comply with the requirements of this Order within 60 days of its effective date, then the approval to lease Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 55725 from September 1, 2004 through September 1, 2007 shall be void. For good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.
- 7. The 20-day time-period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, re-argument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Order.

- 8. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
