#### A. Statement

1. On March 1, 2004, the Town of Castle Rock filed an application requesting authority to widen Fifth Street at the crossing of the Union Pacific Railroad Company (UPRR) tracks.

2. The Commission gave notice of this application to all interested parties, including adjacent property owners in accordance with § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S. The Notice was mailed March 30, 2004.

3. On April 28, 2004, UPRR filed an Entry of Appearance and Notice of Intervention.

4. On May 3, 2004, the Burlington Northern and Santa Fe Railway filed a motion for late intervention. The motion was granted on June 1, 2004 by Decision C04-0568

5. The Commission has reviewed the record in this matter and deems that the application is complete within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.

6. All exhibits, specifications and plans are complete, accurate and meet Commission requirements.

7. The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter under 40-4-106(2)(a) & (3)(a),

8. The Commission now refers this application to an administrative law judge for determination of its merits, including the status of the final contract between the parties for construction and maintenance of the crossing.
