**I. BY THE COMMISSION:**

**A. Statement**

1. On August 20, 2004, the Union Pacific Railroad Company filed an application requesting authority to relocate tracks and construct additional track under Sheridan Boulevard in Arvada, Colorado.

2. The Commission gave notice of this application to all interested parties, including adjacent property owners in accordance with § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S. The Notice was mailed August 26, 2004.

3. On September 7, 2004, the Burlington Northern and Santa Fe Railway filed an Entry of Appearance and Notice of Intervention.

4. The Commission has reviewed the record in this matter and deems that the application is now complete within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.

5. All exhibits, specifications and plans are complete, accurate and meet Commission requirements.

6. The Commission has jurisdiction in this matter under § 40-4-106(2)(a) & (3)(a), C.R.S.

7. The Commission now refers this application to an administrative law judge for determination of its merits, including the status of the final contract between the parties for construction and maintenance of the crossing.

1. This application is deemed complete within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.
