**I. BY THE COMMISSION:**

**A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions**

1. On August 30, 2004, Parker Adult Day Care, LLC (Parker Adult Day Care) filed an application for permanent authority to conduct operations as a contract carrier by motor vehicle for hire for the transportation of passengers and their baggage between all points in the Counties of Adams, Arapahoe, Denver, Douglas, and Jefferson, State of Colorado. This application is restricted as follows: (1) to providing transportation services only for passengers who are clients of Parker Adult Day Care, LLC; (2) to the transportation of passengers who are clients of Medicaid and where the transportation charges are paid by Medicaid; and (3) to providing transportation services that originate or terminate at the facilities of Parker Adult Day Care, LLC, 2600 S. Parker Road, Building 111, Aurora, CO 80014.

2. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on September 7, 2004. The Commission set this matter for hearing on November 15, 2004.

3. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

4. The information submitted with this application warrants granting the requested authority.

5. A present and special need for the requested transportation service exists. A grant of the requested authority will not impair the efficient public service of any authorized common carrier providing a similar service.

## **II. ORDER**

### **A. The Commission Orders That:**

1. The hearing set for November 15, 2004, is vacated.

2. This application was deemed complete on October 14, 2004 within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.

3. Parker Adult Day Care is granted authority to operate as a Class B contract carrier by motor vehicle for hire with authority as set forth in the Appendix. This Order is a PERMIT.

4. Parker Adult Day Care shall operate in accordance with all applicable Commission rules and regulations.

5. Parker Adult Day Care shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Parker Adult Day Care shall file a proper tariff and pay the issuance fee and annual vehicle identification fee. Parker Adult Day Care may not begin operations until these requirements have been met and it has received notice in writing from the Commission stating that it is in compliance and may not begin service.

6. If Parker Adult Day Care does not comply with the requirements of this Order within 60 days of its effective date, then the authority to conduct operations shall be void. For good cause shown, the Commission may grant additional time for compliance if the request for additional time is filed within the 60 days.

7. The 20-day time-period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, re-argument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Order.

8. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
