**I. BY THE COMMISSION**

**A. Statement and Findings of Fact:**

1. On September 17, 2004, Teligent Services, Inc. (Teligent), and Startec Global Licensing Company filed an application to transfer customer assets in Colorado.

2. On September 21, 2004, the Commission received a letter from Counsel for Teligent withdrawing the application. The Commission will construe the September 21, 2004 letter from Teligent as a motion to withdraw the application.

3. Counsel for Teligent has represented in its motion to withdraw that the affected customers receive deregulated services (resold interexchange services) and its application to transfer does not apply.

**II. ORDER**

**A. The Commission Orders That:**

1. Good cause having been shown, the Commission grants the motion by Teligent Services, Inc. to withdraw the application.
