**I. BY THE COMMISSION**

**A. Statement and Findings of Fact**

1. On October 19, 2004, Colorado Communications, LLC, (Colorado Communications) filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide local exchange telecommunications services.

2. On November 15, 2004, the Commission received a letter from Colorado Communications indicating it wished to withdraw its application. The reason stated for the request to withdraw its application was due to a change in business plans of the company.

3. The Commission will construe Colorado Communications' letter as a motion to withdraw the application.

4. Good cause having been shown, the Commission will grant the motion to withdraw the application.

**II. ORDER**

**A. The Commission Orders That:**

1. The letter of Colorado Communications, LLC to withdraw its application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is construed as a motion to withdraw and is granted.
