I. BY THE COMMISSION:

A. Statement, Findings and Conclusions

1. On October 18, 2004 Moonlight Adventures, LLC doing business as Canyon Bikes (Canyon Bikes) filed an application seeking authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) PUC No. 53533S from October 15, 2004 through November 15, 2004.

2. Canyon Bikes under CPCN PUC No. 53533S is authorized to provide service only from April 1 through November 15 of the same year.

3. The Commission noticed this application to all interested persons, firms, and corporations pursuant to § 40-6-108(2), C.R.S., on November 1, 2004. The Commission set this matter for hearing on January 3, 2005.

4. No petition to intervene or otherwise participate in this proceeding has been filed. This proceeding is uncontested. Under § 40-6-109(5), C.R.S., this matter may be determined without a hearing.

5. The information submitted with this application warrants granting the requested suspension.

6. The application for authority to suspend CPCN PUC No. 53533S is in the public interest.

II. ORDER

A. The Commission Orders That:

1. The hearing set for January 3, 2005 is vacated.

2. This application was deemed complete on December 7, 2004 within the meaning of § 40-6-109.5, C.R.S.

3. The application filed by Canyon Bikes for authority to suspend operations under Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity PUC No. 53533S is granted.

4. The suspension of motor vehicle operations under CPCN PUC No. 53533S is authorized from October 15, 2004 through November 15, 2004.


5. Prior to reinstatement on April 1, 2005 Canyon Bikes shall cause to be filed with the Commission certificates of insurance as required by Commission rules. Canyon Bikes shall also pay the appropriate vehicle identification fee.

6. The 20-day time-period provided by § 40-6-114(1), C.R.S., to file an application for rehearing, re-argument, or reconsideration shall begin on the first day after the Commission mails or serves this Order.

7. This Order is effective on its Mailed Date.
