#### A. Statement

- 1. On November 12, 2004, the Crystal Valley Metropolitan District No.1 filed an application requesting authority to construct a new grade separation at the Union Pacific Railroad Company (UPRR) crossing at Crystal Valley Parkway over Plum Creek.
