**I. STATEMENT**

1. On January 15, 2004, a Status Conference was held. Appearances were entered by counsel on behalf of Qwest Corporation, Staff of the Public Utilities Commission, the Colorado Office of Consumer Counsel, AT&T Communications of the Mountain States, Inc., TCG-Colorado, SunWest Communications, Inc., WorldCom and its regulated subsidiaries, Dieca Communications, Inc., doing business as Covad Communications Company, Level 3 Communications, LLC, XO Colorado, LLC, and Time Warner Telecom, LLC.

2. The parties indicated that although they have been engaged in substantial settlement negotiations, it is now apparent that a comprehensive settlement cannot be achieved.

3. The parties agreed that it is now appropriate to reschedule dates for comments.

**II. ORDER**

**A. It Is Ordered That:**

1. Staff of the Public Utilities Commission shall on or before February 27, 2004 file Staff's report.

2. Comments to Staff's report are due on or before April 9, 2004.
3. Replies to the April 9, 2004 comments are due on or before May 28, 2004 by Qwest Corporation, Staff of the Public Utilities Commission, and the Colorado Office of Consumer Counsel.
4. This Order is effective immediately.
