I. <u>STATEMENT</u>

1. On March 12, 2004, Aquila, Inc., doing business as Aquila Networks - WPC (Aquila), filed a Motion for Protective Order Affording Extraordinary Protection to Confidential Information (Motion) in the captioned matter. The Motion seeks to limit dissemination of the cost of service model software Aquila acquired under a licensing agreement with Threshold Associates, Inc. pursuant to 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-16-3.2.

2. The Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission and the Colorado Office of Consumer Counsel have filed responses objecting to the relief requested by the Motion.

3. On March 31, 2004, the Commission referred the Motion to an administrative law judge (ALJ) for resolution. *See*, Decision No. C04-0335. It directed the ALJ to set an expedited hearing for the purpose of receiving oral argument/comment from the parties in support of their respective positions.
