I. STATEMENT

1. On June 1, 2004, WWC Holding Company, Inc. (Western Wireless), filed its Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Parties' Statements of Position and for Waiver of Response Time. On June 2, 2004, Western Wireless filed an Errata Motion to replace the motion that was filed on June 1, 2004. By this Motion Western Wireless seeks a one-week extension of time to file statements of position in this matter. As grounds for the Motion Western Wireless states that on May 26, 2004 the Commission released Decision No. C04-0545, *In the Matter of the Application of Western Wireless Holding Company, Inc., for Designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier*. Western Wireless further states that the Decision contains 68 pages of analysis of Western Wireless' previous eligible telecommunications carrier application, which raised many of the same issues of law and fact raised in the instant docket. The parties seek additional time to incorporate that decision into their statements of position in this matter. Finally, the motion states that all parties have been contacted and no party is opposed to granting an extension of seven days for each party to file their statements of position.

2. Response time to the motion will be waived. Good grounds having been shown the motion will be granted.¹

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. The Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to File Parties' Statements of Position and for Waiver of Response Time filed June 1 and 2, 2004 is granted. Statements of position in this proceeding shall be filed no later June 11, 2004.

2. This Order shall be effective immediately.
