I. <u>STATEMENT</u>

1. On August 3, 2004, Intervenor Golden West Commuter, LLC (Golden West) filed its Motion to Dismiss and Alternate Motion *In Limine*, Motion for Shortened Response Time and Postponement of the Hearing, and Motion for Attorney's Fees.
