**I. STATEMENT**

1. On August 5, 2004, the Staff of the Colorado Public Utilities Commission (Staff), filed a Motion to Vacate and Reset Hearing (Motion) in the captioned proceeding. The Motion requests that the hearing of this matter, currently scheduled for August 20, 2004, be vacated and re-scheduled to a later date. Response time to the Motion was shortened to August 12, 2004. *See*, Decision No. R04-0924-I.
