**INTERIM ORDER OF
ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE

I. STATEMENT

1. On August 17, 2004, Complainant, the Public Utilities Commission of the State of Colorado (Commission), filed a Motion to Vacate Hearing (Motion) in the captioned matter. The Motion requests that the hearing of this matter, currently scheduled for August 26, 2004, be vacated and re-scheduled to a later date due to the unavailability of the Commission's counsel and witness.

2. On August 18, 2004, response time to the Motion was shortened to August 23, 2004. *See*, Decision No. R04-0979-I.

3. On August 20, 2004, the Commission's counsel discussed the Motion with the Respondent, Centennial Limousine, Inc. (Centennial), and informally advised the undersigned that Centennial did not oppose the Motion and that the parties had agreed that October 4, 2004, would be a mutually convenient date for a re-scheduled hearing. Accordingly, the Motion will be granted and the hearing of this matter will be re-scheduled on that date.
