I. STATEMENT

1. The captioned proceeding is currently set for hearing on December 21, 2004. *See*, Decision No. R04-1109-I.

2. On October 1, 2004, the Union Pacific Railroad Company (UP) filed a Motion to Reset Hearing Date (Motion). In support thereof, UP indicates that its primary witness will be unavailable on the current hearing date. It requests that the hearing be re-scheduled to the second week in January 2005.

3. Responses to the Motion were due on October 15, 2004, but none were filed. *See*, Rule 22(b) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 4 *Code of Colorado Regulations* 723-1-22(b). Therefore, the Motion is unopposed.

4. Good grounds having been shown, the Motion will be granted. The hearing will be re-scheduled for January 10, 2004, and the procedural schedule previously established by Decision No. R04-1109-I will be modified as set forth in the Order that follows.

II. ORDER

A. It Is Ordered That:

1. The hearing of this matter scheduled for December 21, 2004, is vacated.
2. This matter is re-scheduled for hearing as follows:

4. The Union Pacific Railroad Company shall file three copies of their list of witnesses and exhibits and shall serve all other parties and the Commission's Staff with a copy of the same on or before December 30, 2004.

5. This Order shall be effective immediately.
